- On River Road
- On the side of the street with the signs “No Parking Sundays 9am–1pm” along Ridgefield Road and Kirkwood Drive

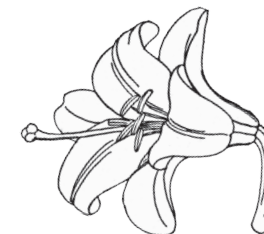
